Wasps can be major nuisance for homeowners and their family members. In some cases, they can also pose a serious public health threat to individuals that are severely allergic to the venom in their stings.

DRIONE contains 1% pyrethrins meaning it works fast and provides long lasting control of nests in wall voids.

DRIONE has been a trusted broad spectrum insecticide for control of ants, bedbugs, cockroaches, fleas, spiders, crickets and silverfish for many years. The addition of wasps to the label adds to this already versatile product, allowing it to serve as a suitable replacement product for Ficam[®] D.

How to Use Drione for Control of Wasps

To control wasps, it is generally advisable to treat nests in the evening when insects are less active and have returned to the nest. Apply 0.25-0.5 g of DRIONE per average size nest. To ensure adequate control of wasps in larger nests, apply 1.0 - 2.0 g of DRIONE per nest. Dust nest and entrance and surrounding areas where insects live. Nests in wall voids can be located by listening with your ear against the wall. Drill a hole in the area, blow dust in, and reseal. For best results check nests carefully one or two days after treatment to ensure complete kill, then remove and destroy nest to prevent emergence of newly hatched insects. If removal is not feasible, retreat the nest again if necessary.
